Savita Jaiswal aged 19 years resides with her parents in a settlement named Shramik Nagar in Navi Mumbai. Savita's mother Tara has been battling tuberculosis and keeps unwell. As luck may have it, Savita's father Shrikant has also lost his arm from the shoulder in an unfortunate accident. This leaves him handicapped and hence is unable to work.

Due to such a precarious condition, Savita is the sole bread earner of the Jaiswal family. Since her mother is undergoing such a bad time, Savita has been irregular at her workplace in a private company where she works as a helper. Due to her poor track record, she has just recently been sacked from work and is currently unemployed.
