

# Livelihood generation through Cost sharing model of 'One Home One Toilet'

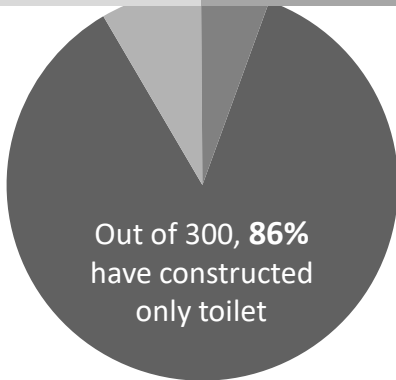

## Case Story of Nocil Naka

One Home – One Toilet project has begun in Nocil Naka settlement, Navi Mumbai since April 2018.

8% have partially upgraded their homes

6 % have fully renovated their homes



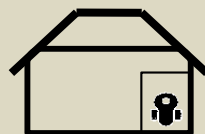
### Cost Sharing Model



Door step delivery of material by SA



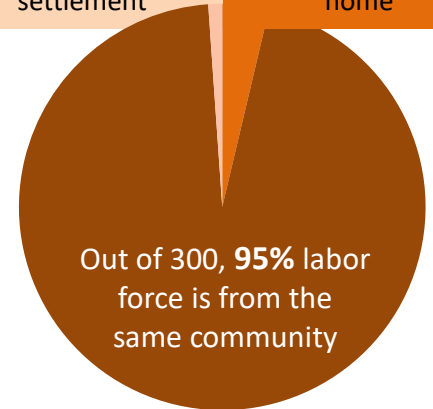
Construction cost is borne by the Beneficiary



**300** Household toilets

Only **1%** labor force is from outside the settlement

**4 %** labor force is from the same home



- ❖ Cost sharing model creates a sense of ownership and ensures a dignified living!
- ❖ It gives freedom and flexibility for beneficiaries to construct their toilet tailored to their needs and based on space availability.

- ❖ It also allows house upgradation as many households have upgraded their house partially or fully along with a toilet resulting in a betterment in lifestyle of these families.

Surveyed 2,25,000+ households



Impacted 9,000 persons



Impacted over 3,60,000 persons through a range of sanitation solutions

## Three steps intervention by SA

SA created Spatial Data of all **2728 Households** along with infrastructure mapping

**72 Community Mobilisation Activities** with girls, women, men and children

Facilitated **300 Household Toilets** on existing drainage network on cost-sharing basis
