

Balaji Nagar, PCMC Mason's Feedback on One Home One Toilet

Shelter Associates' methodology is based on a cost sharing model where material for an individual toilet is provided to the beneficiary family at their doorstep free of cost but they undertake the construction of the toilet at their own cost. In Balaji Nagar, a slum in Pimpri-Chinchwad, 75 toilets were constructed in the first phase. All toilets were constructed by local masons who resided in the settlement for a discounted price.
